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| Food | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BYO food and drink for the day. Children will <u>NOT</u> be permitted to purchase from the shop. Parents are asked NOT to buy food for their children |
| Supervision | <p>Children will come to school as per normal to do the role in their classes. They will travel with their class and then sit with their faction in the stands.</p> <p>There will be one teacher and one Education Assistant per faction bay as well as the staff who are close by performing other roles.</p> <p>One teacher will be in the water for those races where children are weak swimmers.</p> |
| Parents | Parents are asked to stay on the opposite side of the pool to the children. Only those helping Mr Hort and who have a helpers badge will be permitted to be near the children. |
| Communication | A staff member will contact you by phone if your child is unwell |
